Suggested itinerary:

Day 01 – KOTA KINABALU – 1BORNEO (Approx. 15KM)

Arrive Kota Kinabalu International Airport (T1/T2) and collect your Hawks rental car and explore the city surroundings. The city, formerly known as "Singgahmata" or "the Place where the Eye Lingers", has risen from the destruction of the last world war to become a vibrant and modern city that still retains its traditional charms. Places of interest: City Mosque, Sabah Museum and the Handicraft Market (Philippine Market). Make your way to Novotel Hotel, 1Borneo where you will pass by the City Mosque, Wisma Tun Mustapha (Sabah Foundation Building) and University. The hotel is located within the area of the biggest Hypermall in Sabah – 1Borneo. A great place for shopping!

Overnight: GRAND BORNEO HOTEL , 1BORNEO (Deluxe Room)



Day 02 – 1BORNEO – KINABALU NATIONAL PARK – KUNDASANG (Approx. 83KM)

Head North to Kinabalu Park now proclaimed as a World Heritage Site, which covers a staggering area of 754 sq. km. Brief stop is made a native market at Nabalub before arriving Kinabalu Park. Upon arrival at Kinabalu National Park, a chance to visit the Exhibit centre and Mt. Garden to reveal some of Mother Nature's miracles. Daily guided walks by the Park are scheduled, ideal for the less adventurous who would rather refrain from exploring the various marked trails on their own. Proceed to Kundasang – Mt Kinabalu Heritage & Spa for your overnight stay (Approx. 8KM from Kinabalu National Park)

Day 03 – KUNDASANG – SABAH TEA – PORING HOT SPRINGS (Approx. 29KM)

Today drive to Sabah Tea Plantation the only organic tea farm in Borneo and one of the few in the world. A trip to the tea garden is both educational and fun, one where visitors can enjoy a variety of recreational activities such as:

***Tea Factory Tour & Plantation Tour.** Includes (a) 1-page handout on tea processing (b) a packet of 50g loose tea leaves.

Best tour time is between 8AM- 12NN - 1 hour, guided, 2 pax minimum. (Factory closes on major public holidays). RM10

* **Batik Painting Color** a pre-drawn design on a silk piece. RM15

* **Fish Massaging** Learn about "tagal" and experience a fish massage at Kg Luanti Baru.

Entrance fee, 30-minutes fish massaging, camera fee, and swim in river included. RM20 (Msians) | RM40 (International)

Proceed to Poring Hot Springs which offers visitors the opportunity for an invigorating dip into its hot sulfur springs. For a closer look at nature, take the 41m high canopy walk which offers a spectacular view of the Borneo Rainforest flora and fauna.

Overnight: MT KINABALU HERITAGE RESORT & SPA, KUNDASANG (Formerly known as Perkasa Hotel) (Standard Room)



Day 04 – PORING HOT SPRINGS – SANDAKAN (Approx. 240KM)

Depart for a long journey to Sandakan, one of Sabah's oldest settlements on the East Coast of Borneo. Hidden amongst a veritable treasure trove of tropical plants and grasses, hug trees and spectacular orchids in bloom, the quaint bungalows of the Sepilok Nature Resort are within walking distance of the world-famous Kabili-Sepilok Forest Reserve, precious home of the last wild Orang-Utans of Northern Borneo. Sepilok Nature Resort also offers the perfect setting for relaxing after a long road trip, before opting for a jungle night walk

Overnight: SEPILOK NATURE RESORT (Standard)



Day 05 – SEPILOK NATURE RESORT – ORANG UTAN SANCTUARY

Set in the lush 4,300-hectare Kabili-Sepilok Forest Reserve, the Sepilok Rehabilitation Centre under the administration of the Wildlife Department of Sabah attracts tourists and researchers alike, giving them the opportunity to watch the Orang Utan up close in their natural habitat. A boardwalk leads you to a viewing gallery and feeding platform where the apes are fed milk and bananas twice a day at 10.00am and 3.00pm by rangers.

Overnight: SEPILOK NATURE RESORT (Standard)

Day 06 – SEPILOK NATURE RESORT – SANDAKAN AIRPORT (Approx. 13KM)

Spend the morning to explore Sandakan Nature City. Drop off your car at the airport before your flight back.
