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Kuala Lumpur City Tour

Kuala Lumpur is fast growing metropolis which always impress visitors with its unique charm and characters. See the contrast between the Indo-Moorish architecture and the ultra modern edifices, the new King's Palace, the National Monument, the beautiful Lake Gardens and the National Mosque. Visit National Museum, view the old Moorish style Railway Station and the Independence Square. At the city centre, photo stops at Petronas Twin-Tower – still the tallest twin building in the world. Tour also include a quick stop at the Malaysia Chocolate Boutique.

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1400 hours | Duration: 3.5 hours



Batu Caves Tour

A short distant from the city outskirt is Batu Caves – a massive limestone outcrop with its interior dominated by a sacred Hindu shrine lined with different deities, located deep inside the high caverns which take 272 steps to reach. Outside the caves, marvel at the 43 metres high golden statue of Lord Murugan. Tour also include a visit to a traditional Malaysian Batik Centre to see how Batik is printed or hand-drawn using wax and dye, and Royal Selangor Pewter Visitor Centre to witness the making of pewter-ware – Malaysian's most distinctive craft.

Departure: Daily 1400 hours | Duration: 3.5 hours



Kuala Lumpur by Night with Dinner

Check out what's so special about the 'Garden City of Lights' start by visiting Chinatown and take a stroll through the night market where lights ablaze and rows of stalls, each with its own specialty goods sold at bargain prices. After that, savour authentic Malaysian food, feel the ambience and culture at Malay Restaurant. During dinner, be entertained by a cultural dance performance. Option to end tour at Bintang Walk – a trendy night spot of Kuala Lumpur.

Departure: Daily 1800 hours | Duration: 3 hours



Historical Malacca with Lunch

A scenic 2-hour drive south of Kuala Lumpur takes you to Malacca, the oldest trading port in Malaysia which had undergone Portuguese, Dutch and British rule. Visit Stadthuys or the Dutch Square and take a walk up St. Paul's Hill, see St. Paul's Church and the 17th Century Dutch tombstones. Stop for a typical 'Nyonya' lunch before or after taking a stroll through the Antiques Row at Jonker Street. Other visits include the famous Portuguese Porta de Santiago and Cheng Hoon Teng, the oldest Chinese temple in Malaysia. Time permitting, photo stop at the Morten Village, a typical Malay village before return journey.

Departure: Daily 0830 hours | Duration: 8 hours



Elephant Sanctuary with Lunch

Under the care of the Malaysia Wildlife Society, the elephant sanctuary is located in Kuala Gandah and serves as a natural rehabilitation centre for orphaned elephants before they are released back into the wilds. On arrival, visitors are encouraged to view an introductory video for a better understanding of this project. You will then have the opportunity to see the elephants roaming, bathing and being fed at certain time. Optional activities like bathing and feeding of baby elephants will be at extra cost. There will be quick stops at either Deer Land or Aborigine Settlement along the way. Local lunch with soft drinks are provided.

Departure: Daily 1000 hours | Duration: 8 hours



Nature in the City

Visit the living nature theme parks in the heart of the Kuala Lumpur city. Begin with the Bird Park for close encounter with countless live and flying birds of local and foreign species. Continue to the beautifully landscaped Butterfly Park where thousands of butterflies from 120 species roam freely in a simulated natural rainforest environment. Last stop is the Orchid & Hibiscus Garden, home to over 800 orchid species from around the world. Among the Hibiscus, Malaysia's national flower, many are local prize winning hybrids.

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1345 hours | Duration: 3 hours



A Glimpse of the Rainforest

Visit the Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) which offers visitors the opportunity of understanding the tropical rainforest ecosystem. Walk through shady nature trails and visit arboretums, among them the Dipte Rocarp, a collection centre of living trees for botanical reference and Bambusetum displaying some 30 species of local bamboo. This trail winds its way through one of FRIM's oldest plantations and boasts of statuesque commercial timber trees. Logging is now prohibited in all rainforest reserves in Malaysia.

Departure: Daily 0830 hours | Duration: 4 hours



Fireflies Phenomena with Dinner

Barely an hour away from Kuala Lumpur is the rustic town of Kuala Selangor, known for its historical past and massive Mangrove Forests where you may spot monkeys and migratory birds. Enjoy dinner in a local restaurant before boating upstream to watch throngs of fireflies sparkle in the thick mangrove along of the river banks of Kampong Kuantan. Very few places in the world will you find such firefly colony – a real phenomena not to be missed when visiting Kuala Lumpur.

Note: Sighting of fireflies is subject to weather conditions

Departure: Daily 1600 hours | Duration: 6 hours



Ipoh Day Tour with Lunch

Approximately 2 hours' drive north of Kuala Lumpur is Ipoh which was once the biggest single tin mine in the world. View Ipoh Railway Station – a building of Moorish architecture often referred to as the 'Taj Mahal' of Malaysia. Drive pass the city centre where many British colonial architecture remain intact. Stop at the original "Old Town White Coffee Cafe" for lunch. Continue journey to Kuala Kangsar, the royal town of Perak. View the majestic Ubudiah Mosque, built in 1917 and remains the most beautiful mosque in the country. Admire the old and new Sultan's Palaces before return journey to Kuala Lumpur.

Departure: Daily 0830 hours | Duration: 8 hours



White Water Rafting with Lunch

Transfer from Kuala Lumpur to Gopeng Town about 2 hours away, then to Ulu Geruntum, the starting point of water rafting activities. Before the start of this challenge, a safety briefing will be given by our appointed guide. It covers a distance of 7 kilometres with 9 big rapids along the way and the whole journey takes around 1.5 to 2 hours. At the ending point, a light meal will be served. After some rest and freshening up, transfer back to Kuala Lumpur.

Departure: Daily 0700 hours | Duration: 8 hours



Kuala Lumpur Grand Tour with Lunch

This tour is ideal for first-time and short-stay visitors to Kuala Lumpur. A compact tour which unveils the beauty and charm of the old and new capital city. Highlights of the tour include photo stops of Petronas Twin Towers, the King's Palace, National Monument and the Independence Square. Visit the National Museum before lunch at a local restaurant. Pass the Little India in Brickfields before the next attraction of Batu Caves – a massive limestone outcrop, with its interior dominated by a sacred Hindu shrine, set deep inside the high caverns which take 272 steps to reach. Outside the caves stands a 43 metres high golden statue of Lord Murugan. Visit a nearby Batik factory to witness how traditional Malaysian Batik is printed or hand-drawn using wax and dye. Final stop is Royal Selangor Visitor Centre where the finest Malaysian Pewters are crafted.

Malaysian food is a fascinating blend of cuisine due to its fusion of diverse cultures, predominantly Malay, Chinese and Indian. Therefore, during your stay in Malaysia, why not learn to cook some Malaysian dishes by taking one or more lessons at LaZat Malaysian Home Cooking Class and bring Malaysia home, tastefully. Savour lunch you helped cooked.

Putrajaya Tour Enroute to Airport

This tour is ideal for departing guests taking the evening flight. Putrajaya, the green Malaysian government administrative centre is about 45 minutes away from the city, enroute to the airport. Visit Taman Warisan or Agricultural Park, a living arboretum for our home-grown fruits and crops, view the imposing landmarks such as the pinkish Putra Mosque, the Putrajaya Lake, and the Prime Minister's office - often referred to as the 'White House' of Malaysia. Before reaching the airport view the Sepang F1 Race Circuit which is now a venue for the World Motor GP Series.

Departure: Daily from 1200 hours | Duration: 4 hours



Putrajaya and Premium Outlets Enroute to Airport

This tour is ideal for departing guests taking the evening flight. Visit Putrajaya, Malaysia's green government administrative centre, view the imposing landmarks such as the pinkish Putra Mosque, the Putrajaya Lake, and the Prime Minister's office - often referred to as the 'White House' of Malaysia. After that visit the newly-opened 'Mitsui Outlet Park' where the latest international branded goods and fashion items are available at factory prices. Up to 2 hours of shopping time will be provided. KLIA is located about 20-minute drive from the park.

Departure: Daily from 1200 hours | Duration: 4 hours



A Heavenly Dining Experience

Transfer from your hotel to Kuala Lumpur Tower, which at 421 metres high, remains as one of the tallest tele-communication towers in Asia. From there take a high speed elevator to the Atmosphere 360 Revolving Restaurant for a sumptuous Malaysian/international buffet dinner and enjoy the breathtaking bird's eye view of Kuala Lumpur – commonly known as the Garden City of Lights. After dinner, be driven to the nearby Bintang Walk, a trendy 2km long café-lined walking street for a stroll before returning to hotel.

Note: Restaurant seating is limited, so please book the tour early to avoid disappointment.

Departure: Daily from 1730 hours | Duration: 4 hours



Kuala Lumpur Night Market Tour

Visit the famous Petaling Street Night Market for a stroll through rolls of stalls, each with its own specialty goods sold at bargain prices. A good combination of local and regional products, and vendors of different ethnic and nationalities. After that proceed to Jalan Alor food street, where you can experience authentic local dishes and delicacies over a 2 km stretch of basic stalls and coffee shops. Dinner at own expense.

Departure: Daily from 1830 hours | Duration: 3 hours



Kuala Lumpur Heritage Trail with Dinner

A unique walking tour of the heritage precinct in the city. View the Sri Maha Mariamman Hindu Temple – built in a human-like shape. Sample a cup of ‘Teh Tarik’ named after an act of mixing tea and milk in the air without spilling it. Next in sight is the Chan See Shu Yuen Association which was constructed in 1906 – a fine example of old Chinese temple architecture. The walk ends at the bustling Chinatown street market where bargain hunters can find items of various description and made. Enjoy dinner at a nearby Malaysian-fusion restaurant before returning to hotel.

Departure: Daily 1700 hours | Duration: 3 hours



Sekinchan Village Experience with Lunch

Sekinchan is an unspoilt fishing village located about one and half hour's drive away from the hustle and buzzle of Kuala Lumpur city. The first eye-catching impression is the vast expanse of green to golden-colour paddy field in the middle of the village. Stop for photo-taking and visit one of the many Rice Mills there for a brief introduction of paddy planting and rice production. After that visit the picturesque fishing village and stop for lunch at a local seafood restaurant. Continue tour to the breezy Redang beach before return journey to Kuala Lumpur.

Departure: Daily 0930 hours | Duration: 8 hours



Genting Highlands Day Tour

Only an hour's drive away from the city lies Genting Highlands, where at 2,000 metres above sea level, the cool air offers a relief from the hot and humid lowlands. The journey includes a 3 kilometres cable car ride – the Genting Skyway which is the longest in Southeast Asia. This entertainment city at the summit offers a large casino, international standard theme parks, amusements and most of restaurants. After a full day of fun, return by Skyway and then again by road back to Kuala Lumpur.

A Day at Sunway Lagoon

Enjoy a fun filled day at the internationally renowned Sunway Lagoon Theme Park located in the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur. The park is separated into different themed lands in Wild Wild West and the Waters of Africa, each boasting their own exciting attractions. Splash in for wet rides on the Voodoo Adventure River or the heart stopping adrenaline rush from the toboggans. Back on dry land, try the roller coaster, inverted pirate ship or some of the other many attractions. A fantastic day for all! Lunch at own expense.
